

LAYKAM, Konstantin E.

Chairman of the Interstate Statistical Committee of the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS-Stat),
appointed by the CIS Council of Heads of Governments, decision of 20th May, 2022.

Born February 15, 1957.

In 1979 graduated from the Ryazan State Radio Engineering University with a degree in "Automated Control Systems" (ACS). Completed postgraduate studies at the Institute of Control Sciences of the Academy of Sciences of the USSR, in 1988 was awarded the Ph.D. in Technology in the specialties "Management in social and economic systems" and "ACS".

From 1981 to 1991, worked his way from a junior researcher to the Head of a laboratory at the Scientific Research Institute of the State Agro-Industrial Committee of the USSR (Gosagroprom of the USSR), was engaged in the agricultural production management, including the development of information technology.

From 1991 to 1993, was CEO of an IT-company.

In 1993 he was elected to the State Duma of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation, was a member of the Committee on Economic Policy and a member of the Committee on Budget, Taxes, Banks and Finance.

From 1996 to 1997, worked as Deputy Head of the Finance Department of the Ministry of Economy of the Russian Federation (the Ministry of Economy of Russia). From 1997 to 1998, headed the Department of Finance, was a member of the Collegium of the Ministry of Economy of Russia, led analytical and forecasting work on financial policy.

In 1998 was appointed Deputy Minister of Labor and Social Development of the Russian Federation. Supervised the work in the field of finance, investment, information technology, analysis and forecasting of the development of the social and labor sphere.

In February 2003, was appointed First Deputy Chairman of the State Committee on Statistics of the Russian Federation (Goskomstat of Russia). In June 2004, was appointed Deputy Head of the Federal State Statistics Service (Rosstat). Headed the development of Russian statistics in such areas as finance, prices, living standards, labor, agriculture, environment, and digital economy. Led the development of methodology, preparation and conduct of the all-Russian agricultural censuses and agricultural micro-census.

Holds the class rank of "Class II Active State Advisor of the Russian Federation".

Has the honorary title of "Honored Economist of the Russian Federation".
