## Main activities during the preparation period





To establish a regulatory base for censuses



To estimate the budget and to identify the sources of financing



To develop and harmonize the national census's program



To chose methods for collecting data from the population



To conduct pilot censuses





#### **NATIONAL CENSUS PROGRAMMS**



The list of questions to be put to the population is being compiled so as

- to ensure continuity with previous population censuses,
- > meet countries' current information needs and
- follow international recommendations.



One important feature of the round 2020 is the fact that the NSS of the CIS countries have agreed on a methodology for obtaining the core questions on migration and the labour force.

"The date of birth of first child" - Kazakhstan, Russia and Tajikistan

"The planned number of children" – Belarus and Kazakhstan

#### Geographic and migration characteristics

"Do you plan to leave the country?" and "If so, for how long?".

Belarus, Kazakhstan and Moldova

"Residence abroad for a year or longer" and "Country and year of arrival"

Azerbaijan, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Russia and Tajikistan
