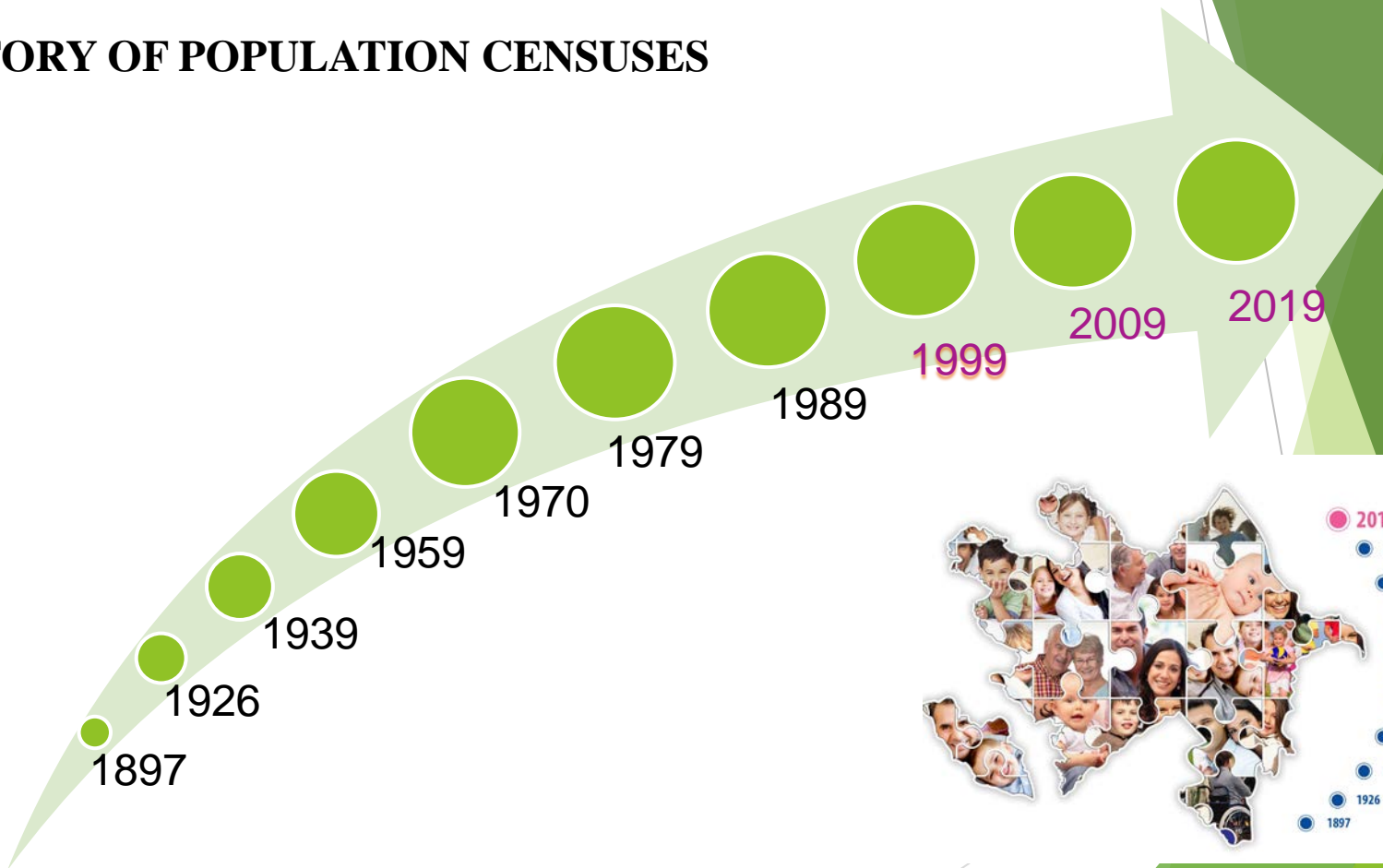

# INTRODUCTION

Modern society is a complex system of generations, differing in age, education level, social activity, and economic status. Analyzing the population's age structure allows us to determine the country's development prospects, the state of the labor market, education system, and social protection.

According to the 2009 census, Azerbaijan's population was approximately 9 million, and by 2019, it had reached 10 million. More than half of the population lived in cities.

# Population structure

Children (0-17 years)	about 28%
Youth (14-29 years old)	about 25%
Working-age population (15-64years)	about 71%
Elderly (65+)	about 7%

Azerbaijan is a country with a relatively young population, where the working-age population predominates.

According to the 2019 census

- About 98% of the population over 25 years of age at least have general secondary education;
- more than 91% completed secondary education;
- the proportion of illiterates was only 0,2%

This indicates a high level of literacy.  
and accessibility of education in the country.



# Children: Formation of Basic Education

According to Article 49 of the Family Code of the Republic of Azerbaijan, children are considered to be persons under the age of 18 (majority) who have not acquired full legal capacity.

Children are the foundation of the future of society. In the structure of the population, they fall into a broader category. According to the 2019 Azerbaijani population census, the proportion of children is about 28% of the population, which indicates the young demographic structure of the country.



# Formation of basic education

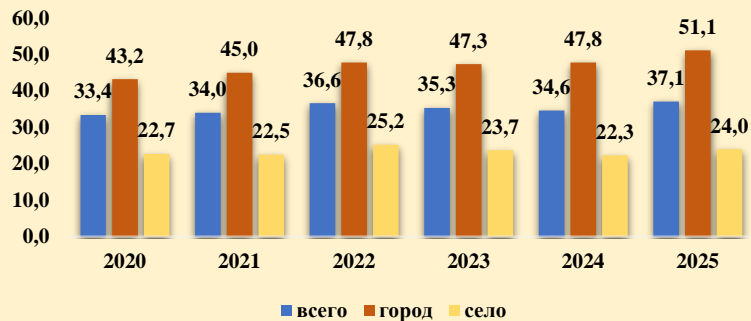
## Total enrollment of children in education

- preschool education – (1-5 years more than 37%, 3-5 years about 55%)
- primary education – more than 105%
- general secondary education – more than 96%
- complete secondary education – more than 87%

## Meaning

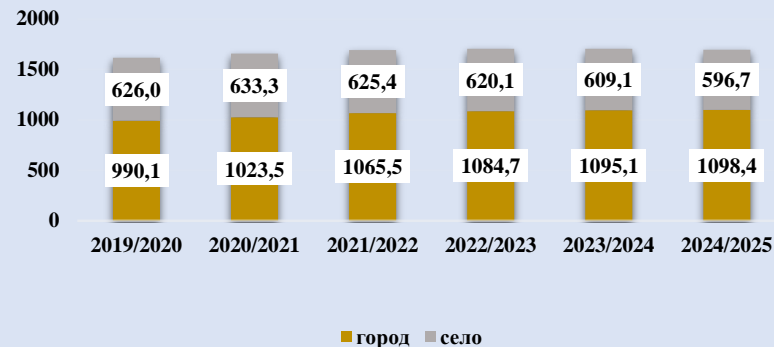
- formation of basic knowledge

## Preschool education coverage for children aged 1-5 years



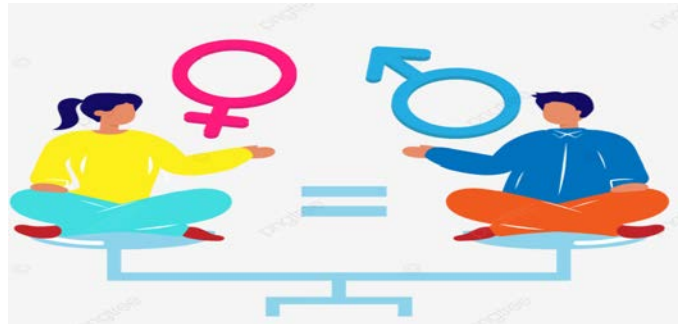
## Number of students in general education institutions

## Youth: Peak of Educational Activity

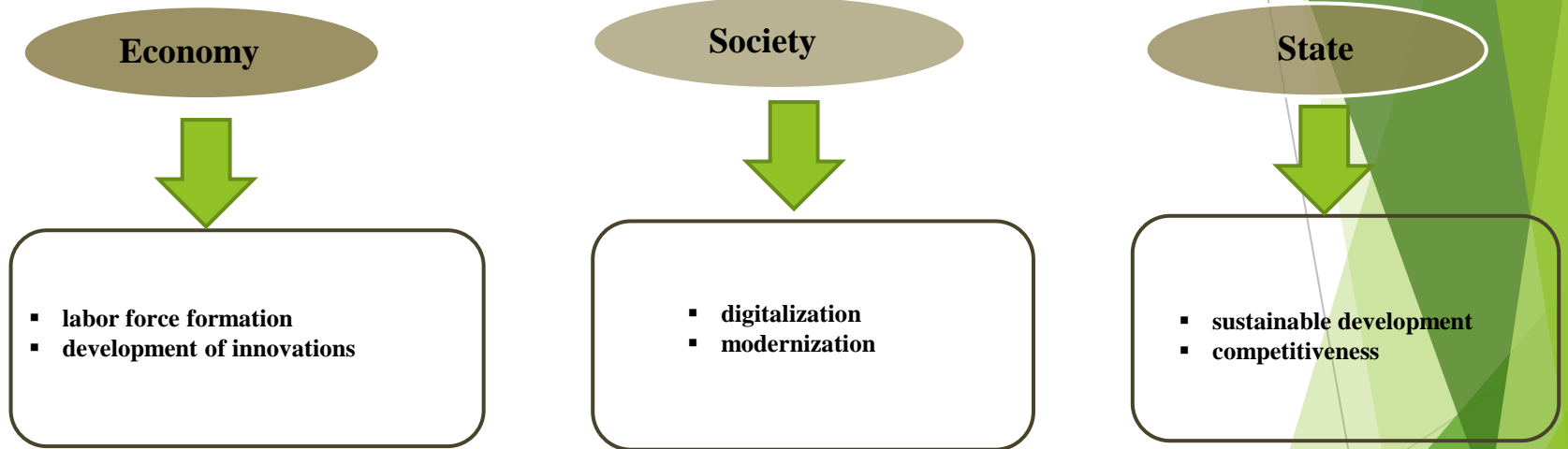
According to the law Republic of Azerbaijan "On Youth Policy", Individuals aged 14-29 are considered youth. Youth occupy a special place in the structure of Azerbaijan's population. This age group is the most active in education and plays a key role in shaping the country's human capital.

According to the 2019 Azerbaijan census, as indicated above, the youth population makes up approximately 25% of the total population.

This makes youth one of the largest and most significant social groups.

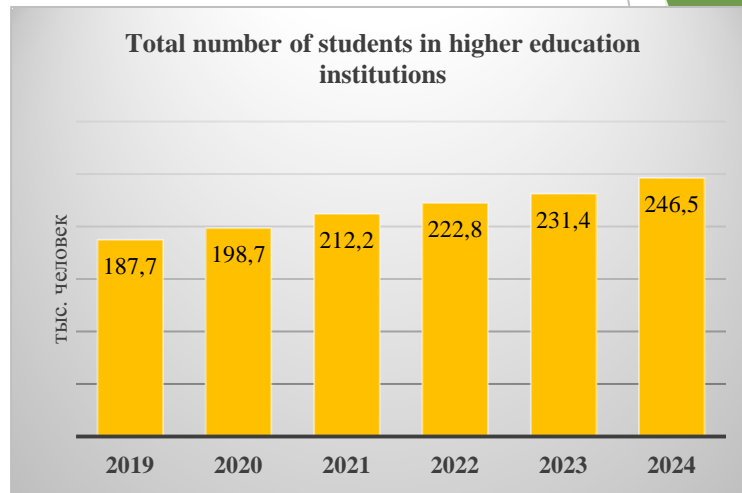
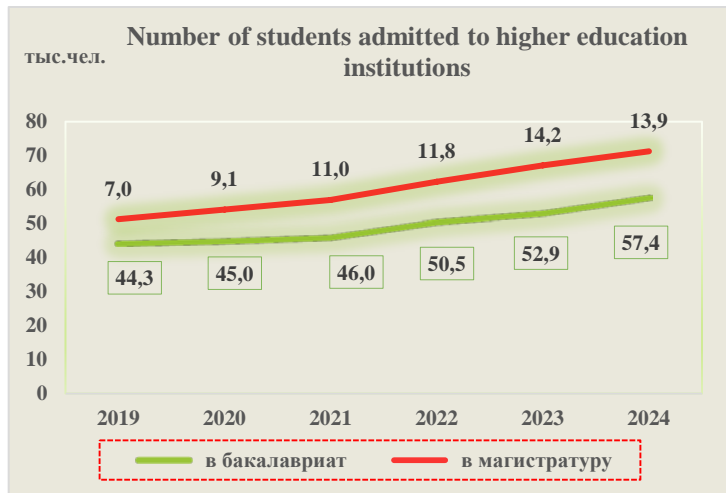

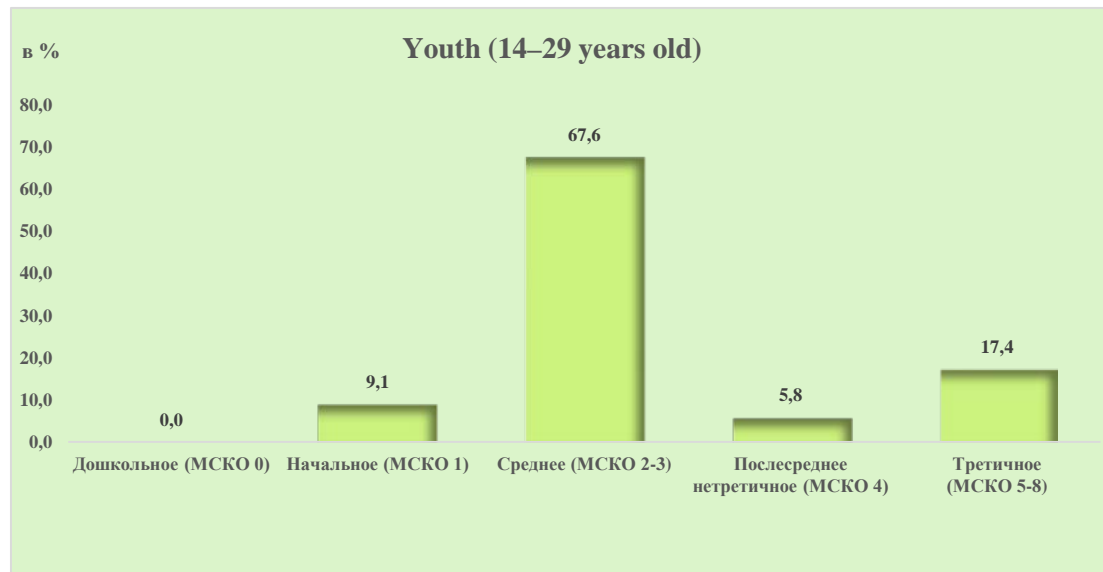

# Working-age population

Working-age population aged 15–64 years — is an international demographic and economic standard used to assess the potential workforce. It is this age group that shapes the labor market, ensures production, economic development, and national stability.

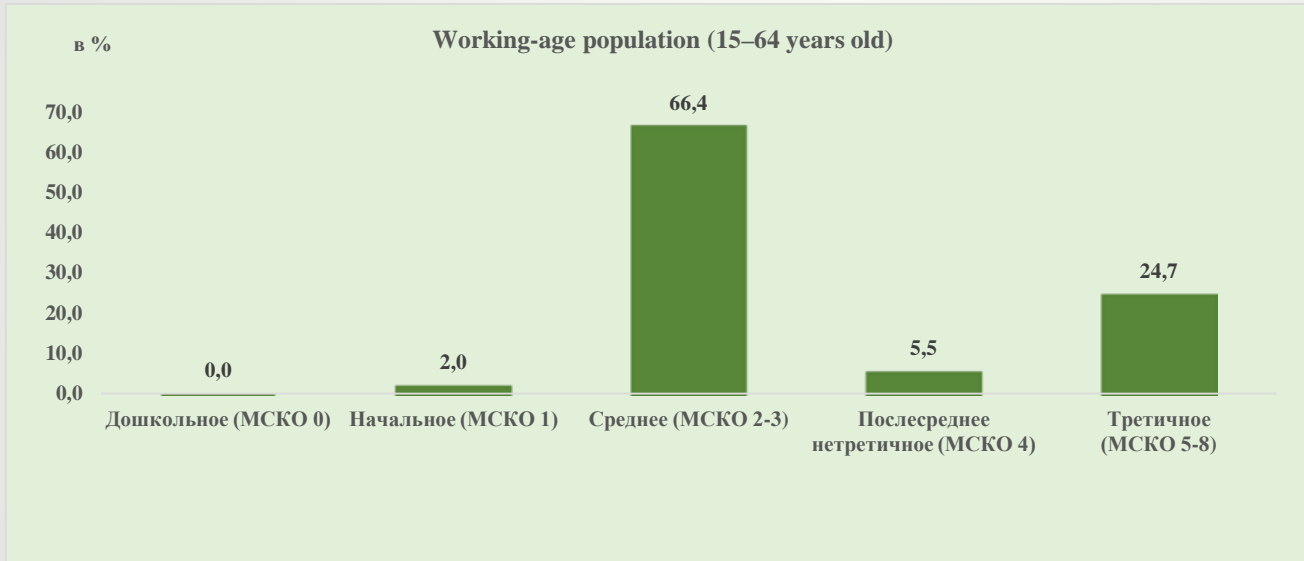
According to the 2019 Azerbaijan census, the working-age population accounts for approximately 71% of the total population, indicating a favorable demographic structure.

The level of education in this group directly impacts labor productivity, employment, and economic growth. It is a key resource for the country's development.

## Elderly population (65+)

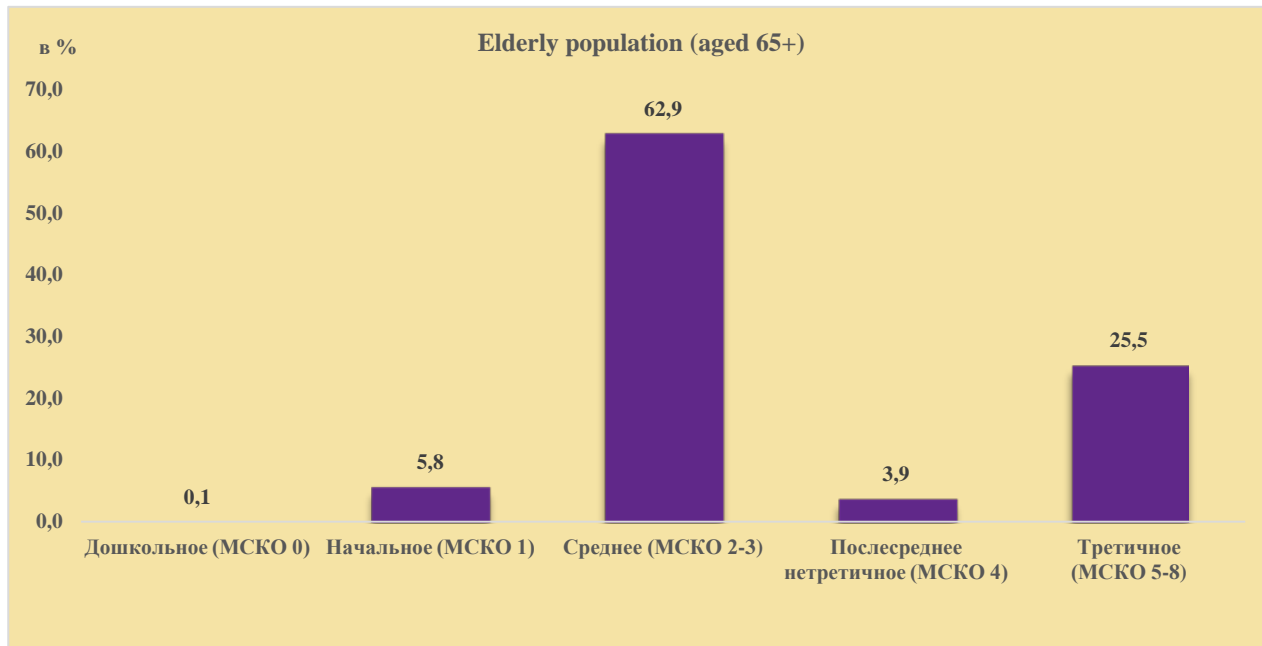
The elderly population (aged 65 and older) constitutes a significant socio-demographic group that shapes the balance between societal development and the economic burden. They serve as living repositories of historical memory and knowledge, and their share of the population and standard of living directly reflect the effectiveness of the country's social and educational policies.

According to data from Azerbaijan's 2019 census, individuals aged 65 and older account for approximately 7% of the population.

Despite lower economic activity, this group plays a significant role in society.

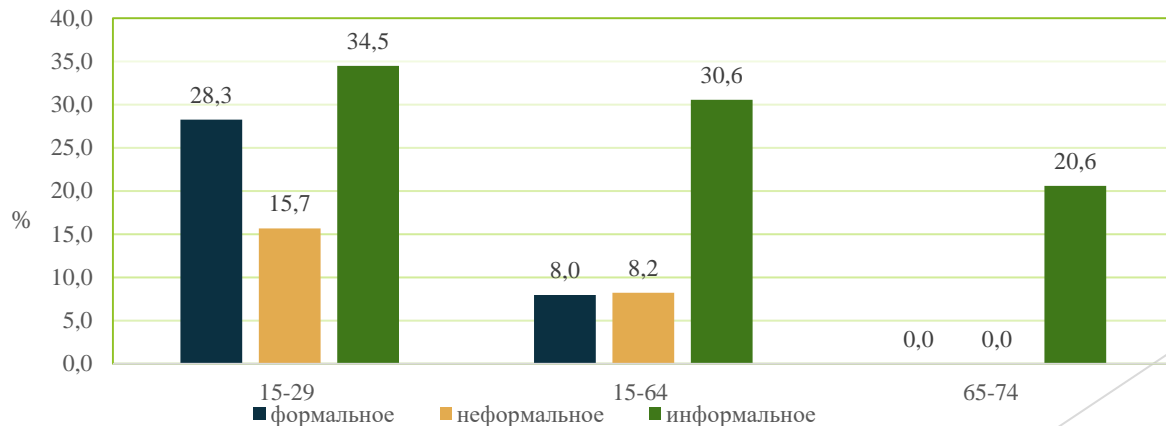


## Lifelong education
