

Valerii Stepanovich Zubakha

Born August 7, 1955, in Semipalatinsk-21, now Kurchatov.

Graduated from the F.E. Dzerzhinsky Military Academy in 1978, specializing in programming.

From 1978 to 1992, he served in the military in the scientific and practical units of the Armed Forces of the USSR and the Russian Federation.

From 1992 to 2001, he worked at the Forensic Science Center of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Russia, where he was responsible for the automation of the Forensic Service. He is a member of the International Organization for Identification and a member of the International Police Organization.

From 2001 to 2005, he worked at the Ministry of Finance of Russia.

In January 2005, he was appointed Deputy Head of the Departmental Programs Directorate of the Federal Treasury and was responsible for the implementation of the World Bank Project to create the "Automated System of the Federal Treasury." Since 2008, he has worked in the Moscow Government as Deputy Head of the Moscow City Informatization Department, overseeing the implementation of the Electronic Moscow project.

From 2009 to February 2011, he was Director of the Electronic Government Project at Rostelecom.

From 2011 to 2025, he held senior positions at major IT companies such as BSS LLC, Control Systems JSC, BFT Holding, and the Federal Budgetary Institution "Scientific Center for Legal Information".

He holds a PhD in Law and is a Corresponding Member of the Russian Academy of Natural Sciences.

He holds the rank of "State Counselor of the Russian Federation, 3rd Class" and "State Counselor of the City of Moscow, 3rd Class."

He is the author of several publications on mathematical analysis and pattern recognition algorithms. His primary area of professional experience is the development of highly complex information systems.

From 2025 to June 2026, he served as Head of the Department of Information Statistical Resources and Technologies at the CIS Statistical Committee. In June 2026, he was appointed Deputy Chairman of the CIS Statistical Committee.

He oversees the CIS Statistical Committee's activities related to the digitalization of statistics, the dissemination of statistical information in electronic and printed form, and the organization of work on the operation and development of information systems and statistical resources.
