












Data Flow in Global SDG Reporting








Custodian Agency by number of SDG indicators



























Proportion of SDG indicators classified by Tiers












Outcomes of audit and verification of discrepancies















Only global indicators are displayed in the UN global database

Data on 179 global SDG indicators are available in the global database, while data on only 110 global indicators are available in the national database

For 77 global indicators, the SDGs differ from those of the global SDG platform

For 78 global SDG indicators, there is data in the global platform, but there is no data in the national one

More disaggregated data are uploaded to the global platform than to the national database

The global platform
contains about 30
additional sub-indicators
that are not available in the
national SDG indicator
reporting platform

Data on 11 SDG indicators are posted on the national reporting platform, but are not available in the UN global SDG platform


