The tasks for achieving the SDGs were included in the NDP until 2026 and are implemented through the annual KMKR plans


Achievements:

- GDP per capita increased to \$2,418
- Average growth rate – 9%
- Unemployment decreased to 4.1%
- 67.8% of graduates achieved functional literacy
- The country moved up to 117th place in the Human Development Index
- The country moved up to 78th place in the E-Government ranking
- The Corruption Perceptions Index improved (27 → 25 points)



Number of extremely poor people








