National Coordination Council for Sustainable Development



The National Coordination Council for Sustainable Development of the Republic of Azerbaijan was established by the Decree of the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan dated October 6, 2016 No. 1066.





National Coordination Council for Sustainable Development

- ✓ Defines national priorities and targets for them in accordance with global goals and objectives that are important for Azerbaijan until 2030.
- ✓ Ensures alignment of state programs and strategies covering socio-economic spheres in the country with the Sustainable Development Goals.
- ✓ Prepares an annual report on the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals.

Responsibility :

According to paragraph 5 of Decree No. 1066

- *The State Statistics Committee of the Republic of Azerbaijan should ensure the processing of statistical data on indicators determined in accordance with the Sustainable Development Goals, and provide relevant information to the Council once a year.*

According to the “Sustainable Development Cooperation Framework between the United Nations and Azerbaijan for 2021-2025”, the goal is to achieve 56.0 percent of the SDG indicators, or 139 indicators, by the end of 2025.

PROJECTS Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey (MICS)



The Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey (MICS) was conducted in Azerbaijan from May to August 2023.

Implemented in accordance with the State Program for the Development of Official Statistics in the Republic of Azerbaijan for 2018-2025.

The Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey (MICS) was conducted to obtain statistical data that ensure international comparability to assess the state of social well-being of mothers and children, assess human development and measure the achievement of the goals defined by the SDGs.

In 2024, a report on the results of the MICS was prepared and published.

The MICS study yielded data on 18 SDG indicators, 10 of which are national priority indicators.

NATIONAL 18TH SDG (MINE RISK ACTIVITIES)

- ❑ The President of the Republic of Azerbaijan, Mr. Ilham Aliyev, initiated the inclusion of the 18th Sustainable Development Goal «Demining» at the "Non-Aligned Movement Contact Group Summit on Combating COVID-19"
- ❑ Approved at the meeting of the National Coordination Council for Sustainable Development on April 18, 2023.
- ❑ The 18th SDG consists of 5 targets and 15 indicators.
- ❑ The Council was instructed to develop, together with the relevant structures, a methodology for the indicators of the 18th SDG and take appropriate measures to calculate the indicators.
- ❑ In 2023, the corresponding methodology of the State Statistics Committee was developed. In 2024, data collection on the indicators of the 18th SDG was started.

Information on Sustainable Development Goals

As a continuation of the Millennium Development Goals, UN General Assembly Resolution A/RES/70/1 of 25 September 2015 approved the "Transforming our World: the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development" consisting of 17 goals and 169 targets designed to contribute to ensuring of the sustainable global development through action of sustainable development for human development.

- ❑ In 2019, the State Statistics Committee created the National Information Portal on the Sustainable Development Goals of the Republic of Azerbaijan on the Committee's server.
- ❑ The portal, where information on the SDGs is disseminated through text, individual graphic images and tables, also includes global goals, objectives and indicators, national SDG priorities
