






LOCALIZATION OF SDGs





The list of **200** national indicators has been updated: **69** relevant and **131** for monitoring.

56 relevant indicators are included in the CGA Development Plans,25 in the Regional Development Programs.





Methodological recommendations on localization of SDGs in the Republic of Kazakhstan have been approved

Seminars on the localization of the SDGs were held (the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Institute of Economic Research), and proposals for updating the indicators were systematized
