

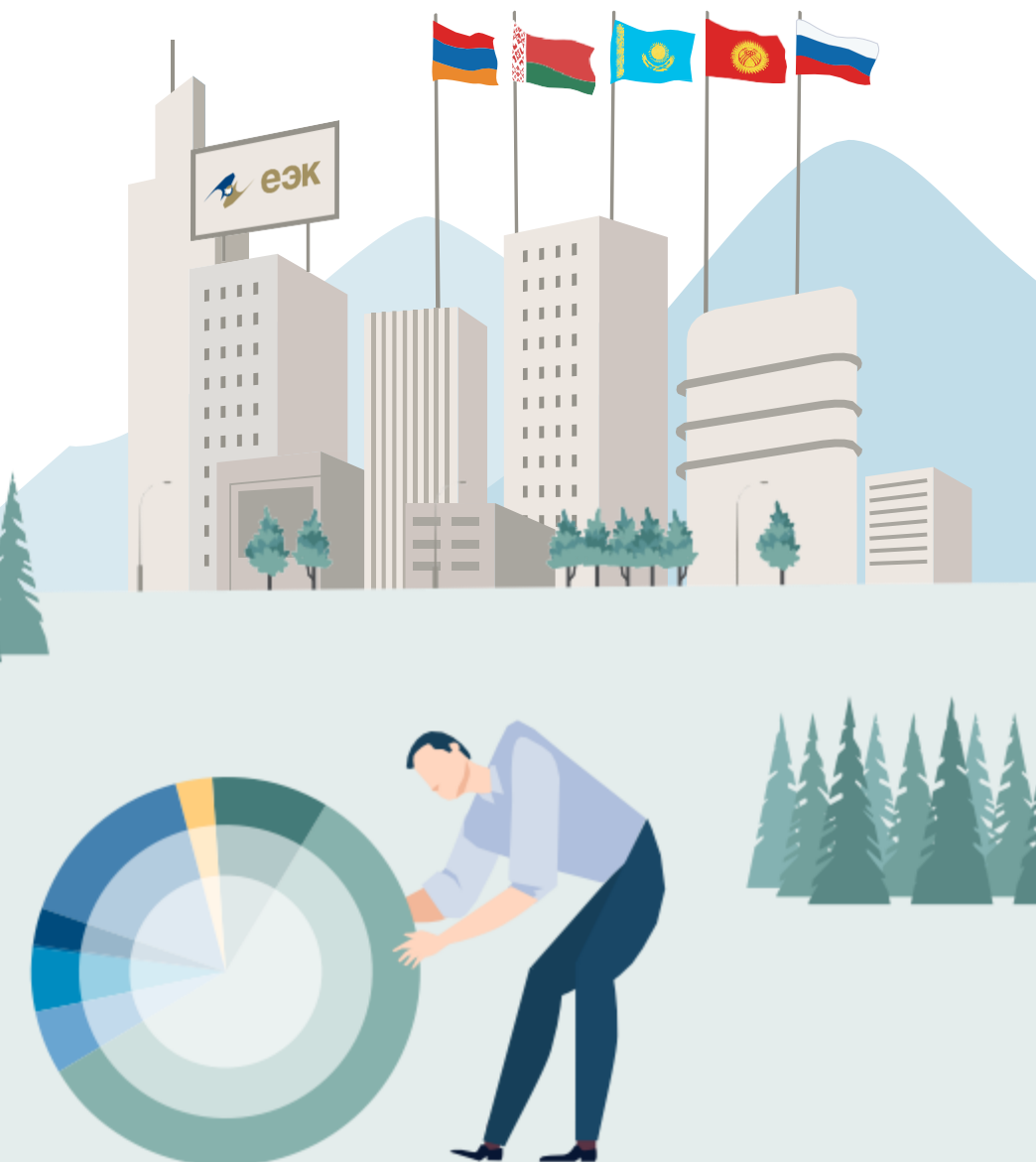
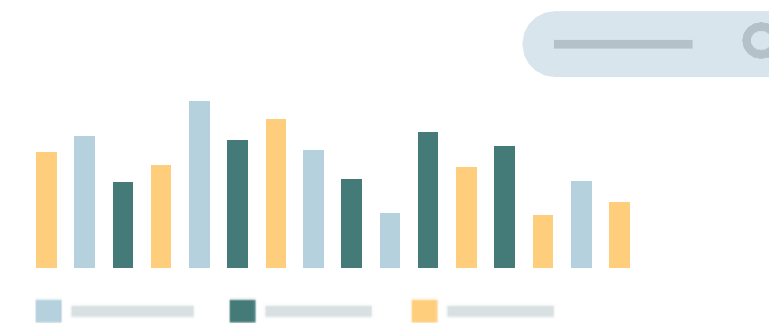
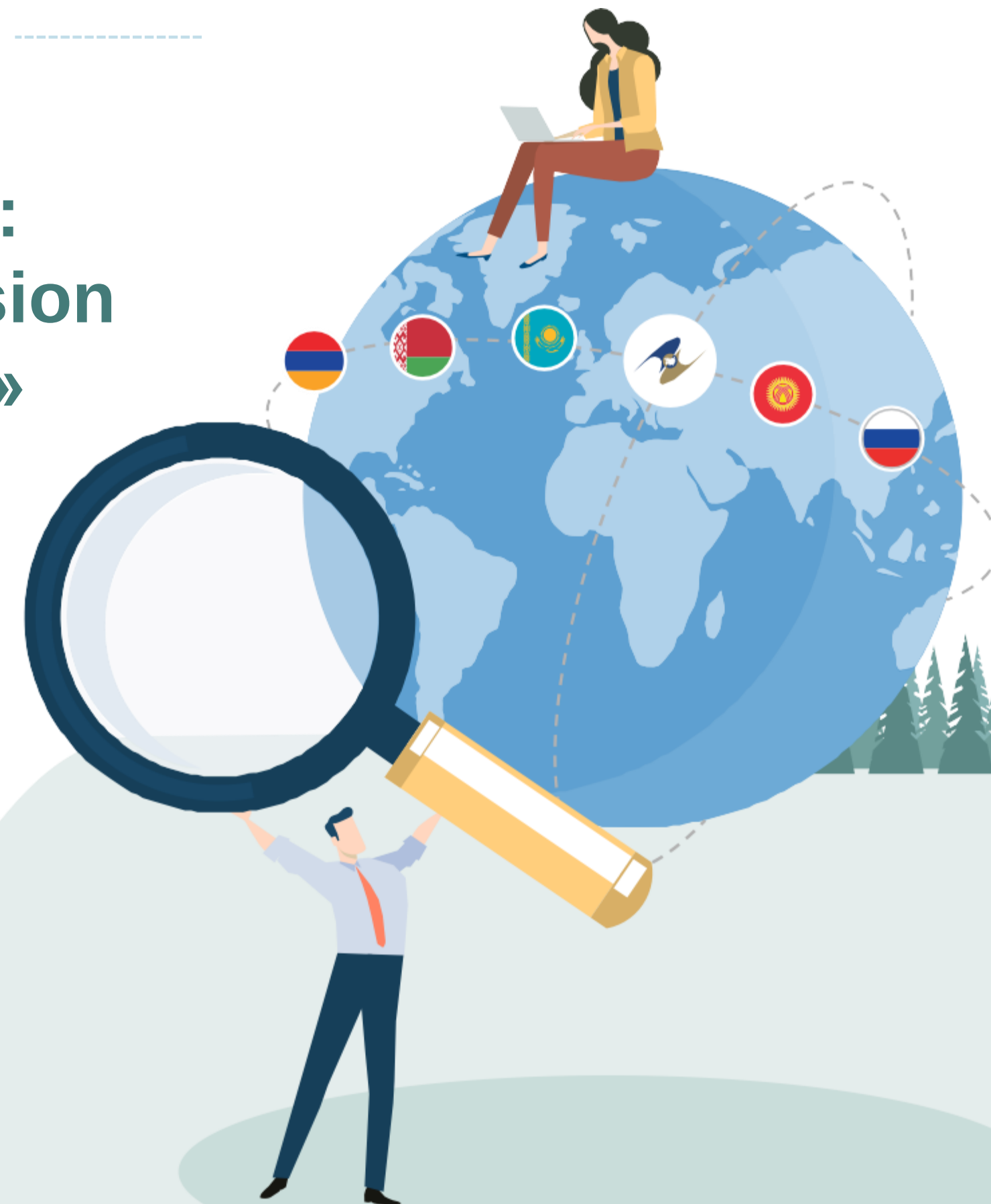

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REPORT

on the achievement of Sustainable Development Goals in the region of the Eurasian Economic Union



■ **In 2017, the EEC presented the first report** "Achieving the UN SDGs in the EAEU Region" within the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development under the auspices of the UN Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC). The report was presented by Mr. Oleg Pankratov, Chairman of the Council of the Eurasian Economic Commission, Deputy Prime Minister of the Kyrgyz Republic.

- The document analyzed the relationship between the depth of integration and progress in implementing the SDGs.
- **Data on 59 indicators from 9 SDGs** are presented for the Union as a whole
- **Covered by a large number of indicators:**
Goal 1 "No poverty"
Goal 9 "Industry, innovation and infrastructure"
- **The EEC regularly presents information on the impact of the Eurasian integration on achieving the SDGs within the EAEU** at the PFSD platform under the auspices of ECOSOC and organizes relevant side events.
- The Commission presents its SDG developments, including at the UN Regional Commissions. In March 2023, the EEC organized a side event within the 10th Asia-Pacific Forum on Sustainable Development under the auspices of UNESCAP.

2023 Sustainable Development Goals Summit

- Mr. Alexei Overchuk, Chairman of the Eurasian Economic Commission's Council and Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Federation, presented the **Joint Statement of the EAEU Member States** on the impact of the Eurasian economic integration on achieving the UN Sustainable Development Goals within the EAEU at the Sustainable Development Goals Summit under the auspices of the UN General Assembly held on September 18, 2023:

...«Each EAEU Member State takes specific steps to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals using national program documents, strategies and development concepts. At the same time, **economic integration within the EAEU is an additional factor contributing to the SDGs achievement.**»...

...«**The well-established work in the field of statistics within the EAEU** makes it possible to expand the number of indicators that can be calculated within the integration association to evaluate progress in achieving the SDGs. For these purposes, **the Member States have determined a list of indicators for achieving the SDGs, with regard to the EAEU development priorities.**»...

...«International cooperation is important in achieving the SDGs. The EAEU stands for an equitable dialog between integration structures and sees this as the key to a more efficient functioning of the global economic architecture.»...

...«Achieving the SDGs is a common goal for which all participants in international relations should join efforts and mobilize existing resources.».





DECLARATION on further development of economic processes "Eurasian Economic Path"



- **The Supreme Eurasian Economic Council's meeting** chaired by Vladimir Putin, President of the Russian Federation and Chairman of the Supreme Eurasian Economic Council, **was held on December 25, 2023 in St. Petersburg** involving the Heads of State of the Eurasian Economic Union and Mikhail Myasnikov, Chairman of the Board of the Eurasian Economic Commission.
- **The Heads of State of the Eurasian Economic Union signed the Declaration on further development** of economic processes within the EAEU until 2030 and for the period until 2045 "The Eurasian Economic Path".
- **The Declaration defines the Union's objectives for the medium term until 2030 on the way to transforming the EAEU by 2045** "into a self-sufficient, harmoniously developed and attractive to all countries of the world macro-region, possessing economic, technological and intellectual leadership and maintaining a high standard of living of the Member States' population".

In order to solve the set objectives, **the key areas of the EAEU development in the fields of economic interaction have been identified**, providing for both the improvement of existing mechanisms and new mechanisms: the use of natural resources for developing cooperative potential, **the development of digital technologies, unlocking the potential of artificial intelligence systems** and ensuring its application, the introduction of innovative approaches in the agricultural sector and others.

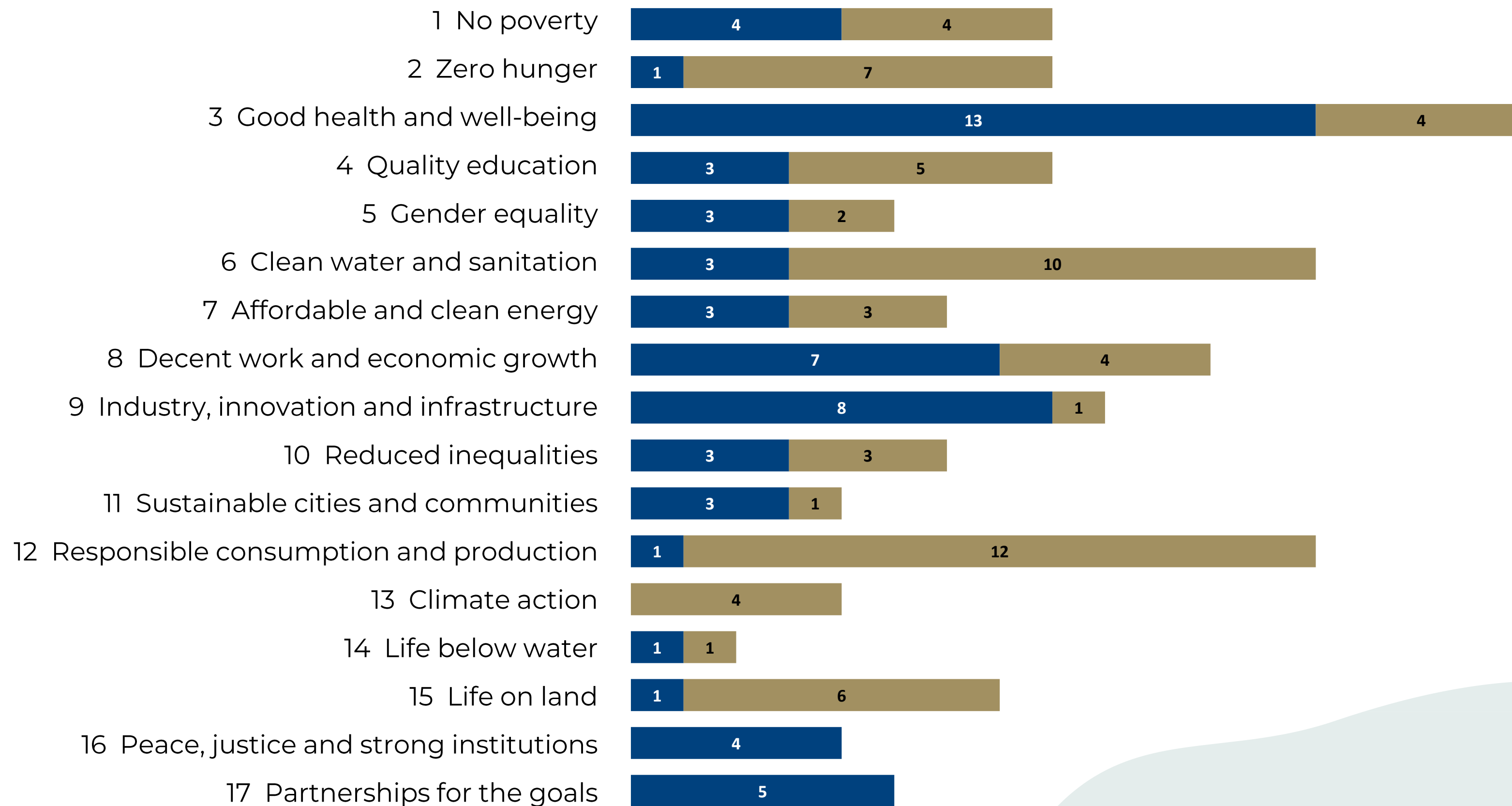

■ Global – 63 indicators

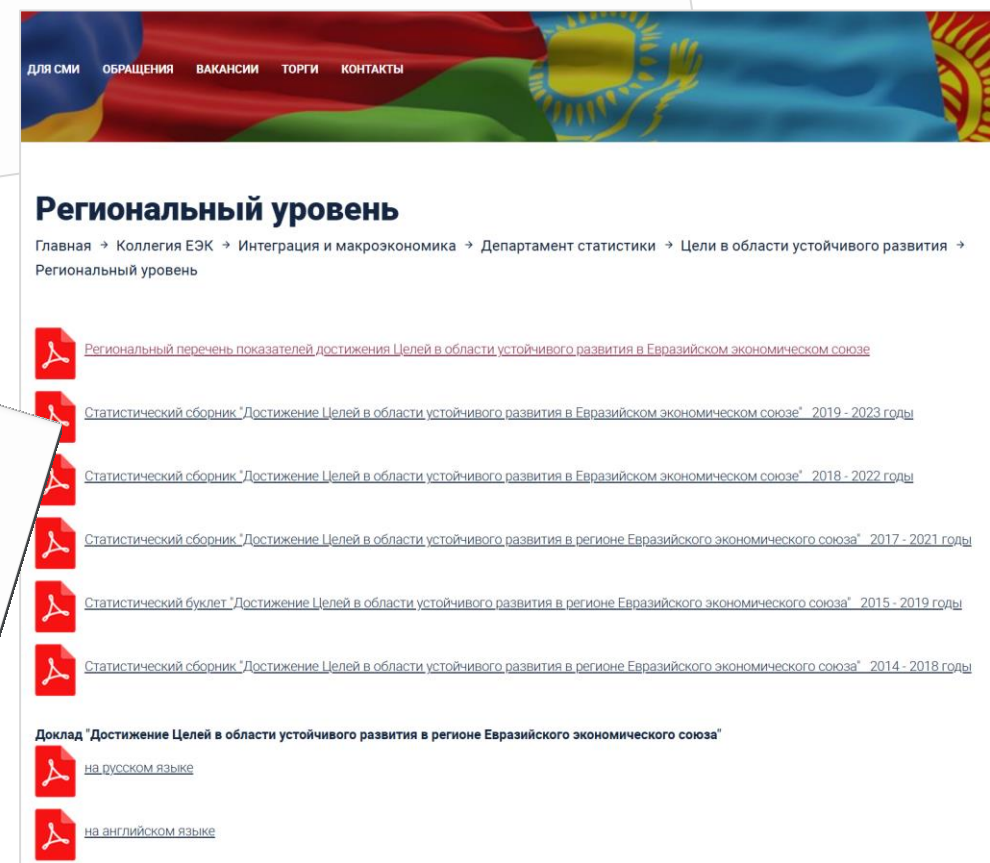
■ Regional – 67 indicators

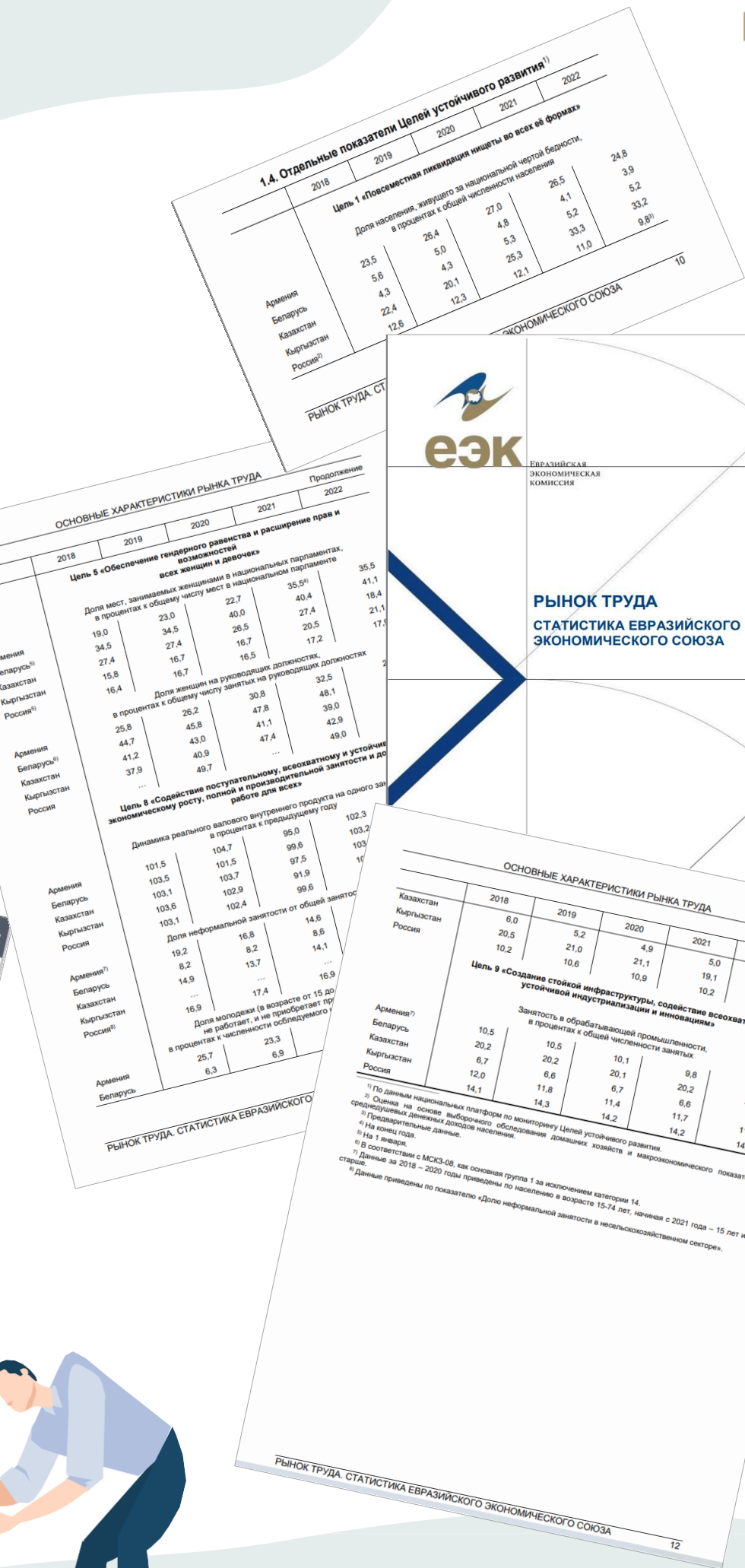
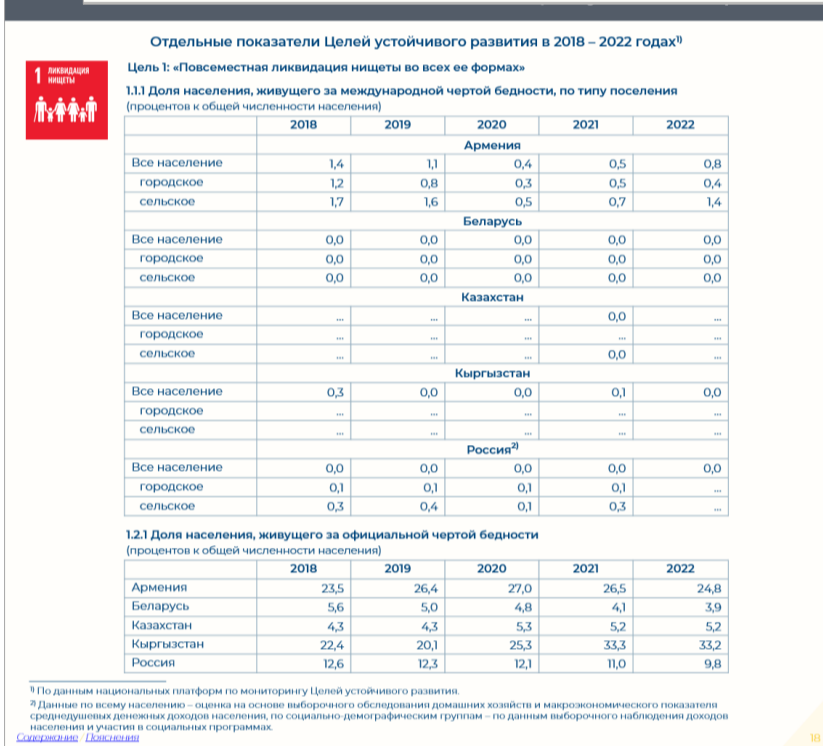
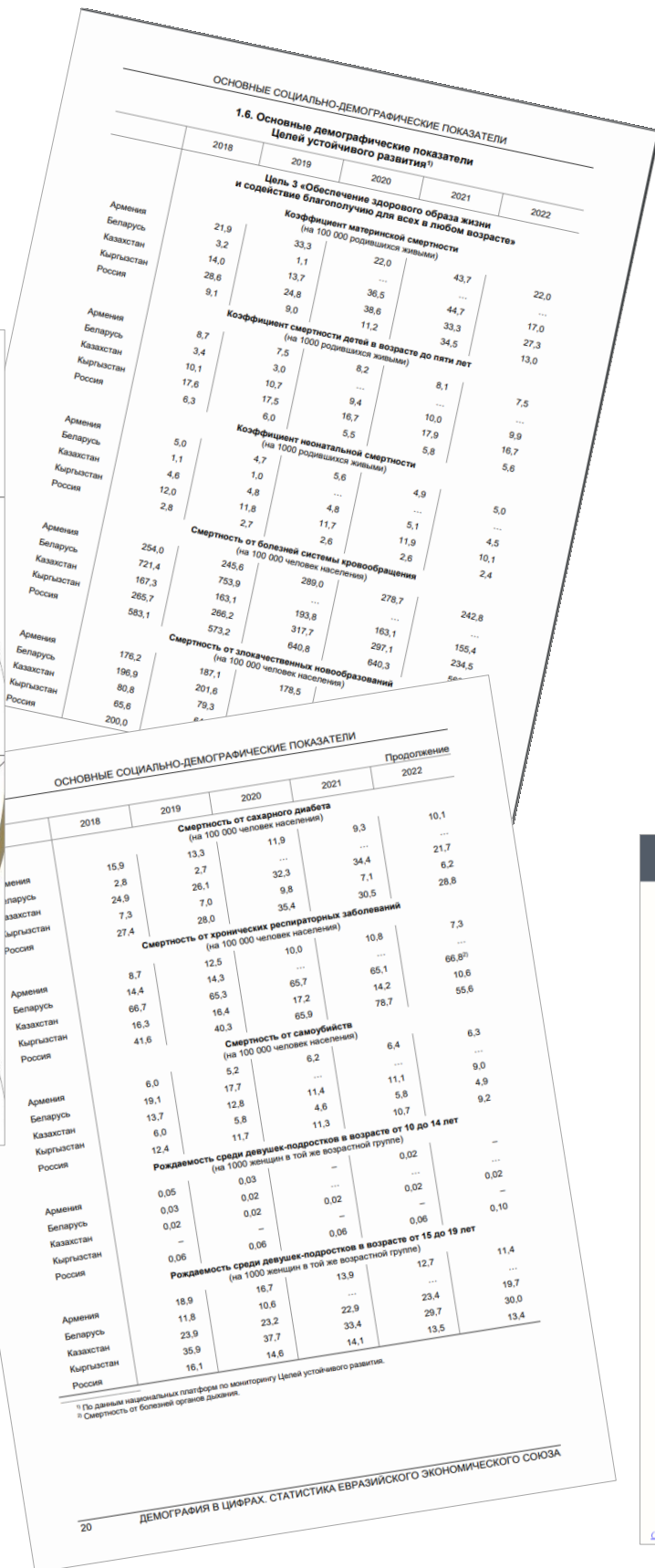


SDGs monitoring in the Eurasian Economic Union

- A single set of macroeconomic indicators - 17 indicators







Meeting of CIS NSO specialists for SDGs

- Date and venue – **April 17-18, 2024, Moscow**
- The event is organized by the CIS Interstate Statistical Committee (CIS Statistical Committee), the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), the Federal State Statistics Service (Rosstat) and the Eurasian Economic Commission (EEC).
- Meeting participants: representatives of national statistical services of the CIS member States, representatives of international organizations (UNFPA, UNECE, UNICEF, ESCAP, CIS Executive Committee, CIS Statistical Committee, Eurasian Economic Commission, etc.).
- The meeting reviewed best practices at both the national and international levels to improve data coverage, the use of **traditional and alternative data sources** to expand available official statistics on the SDGs, including the use of **census data** in monitoring SDG indicators; issues of data processing, visualization and analysis for monitoring the SDGs using modern tools communication, **geospatial data and artificial intelligence**.





International seminar "Strategic vectors of statistical development of the Eurasian Economic Union until 2030"

- Date and venue – **May 15-16, 2024, Moscow**
- The event is organized by the Eurasian Economic Commission (EEC) and the Plekhanov Russian University of Economics.
- **The purpose** of the seminar is to develop a strategic action plan in the field of statistics in order to provide users with up-to-date data that meets modern challenges, outline new data collection opportunities in the context of global digitalization and **create a roadmap for the development of statistics in the region of the Eurasian Economic Union until 2030**, taking into account the provisions of the Declaration on the Further Development of Economic Processes within the Framework of the Eurasian Economic Union until 2030 and for the period up to 2045 "The Eurasian Economic Way".
- The main topics for discussion were issues of harmonization of statistical methodology in the era of data evolution, modernization of digital infrastructure, integration of statistical and geospatial information, use of alternative sources of information and artificial intelligence tools for data collection, visualization and analysis, which **formed the basis of the priority areas of the Concept of the EAEU Statistical Integration Program for 2026-2030**.
