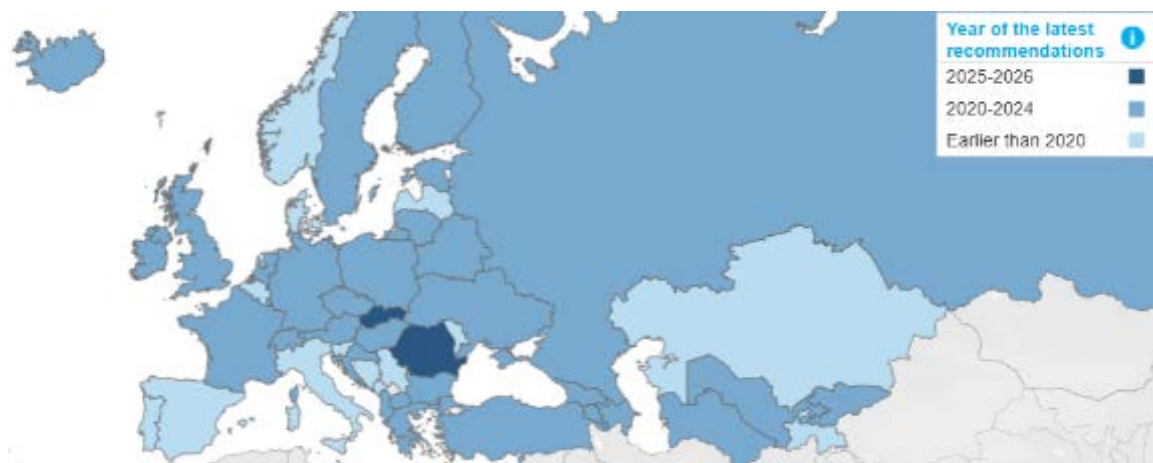

Better data, evidence and data  
systems for children



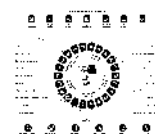
1. Effective coordination, harmonisation and sharing of data with line ministries.



2. Disseminating data on children in accessible formats/data analysis and use in policymaking.



3. Data disaggregation and collection with a focus on the most vulnerable children.



4. Centralised, integrated, comprehensive data collection system and database covering all child rights.

- Adequate Standard of Living

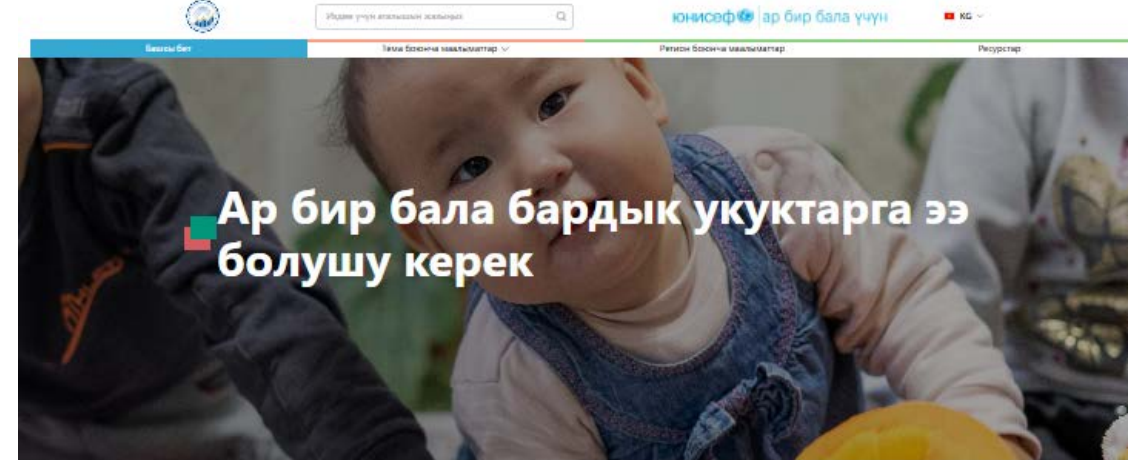

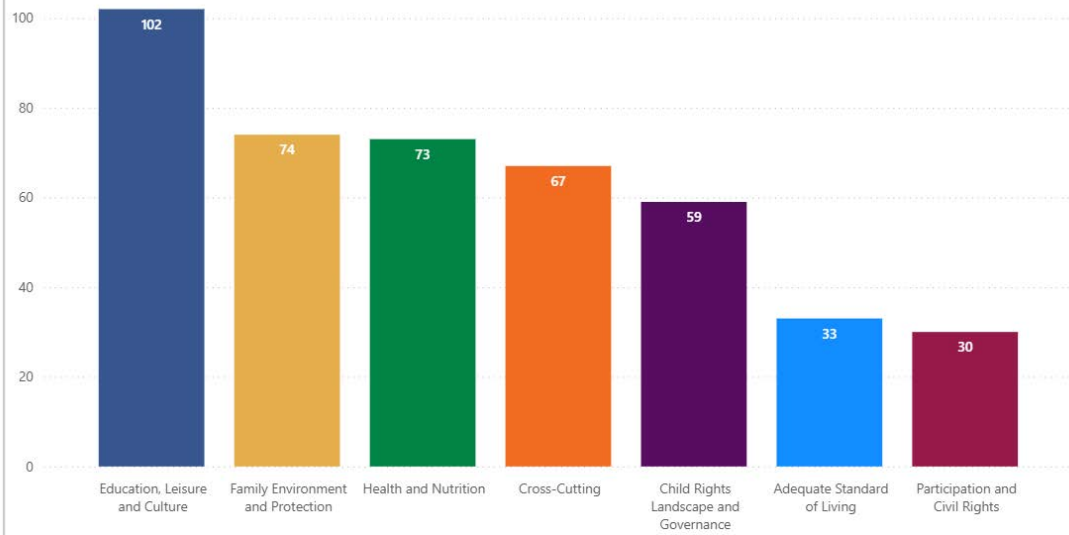

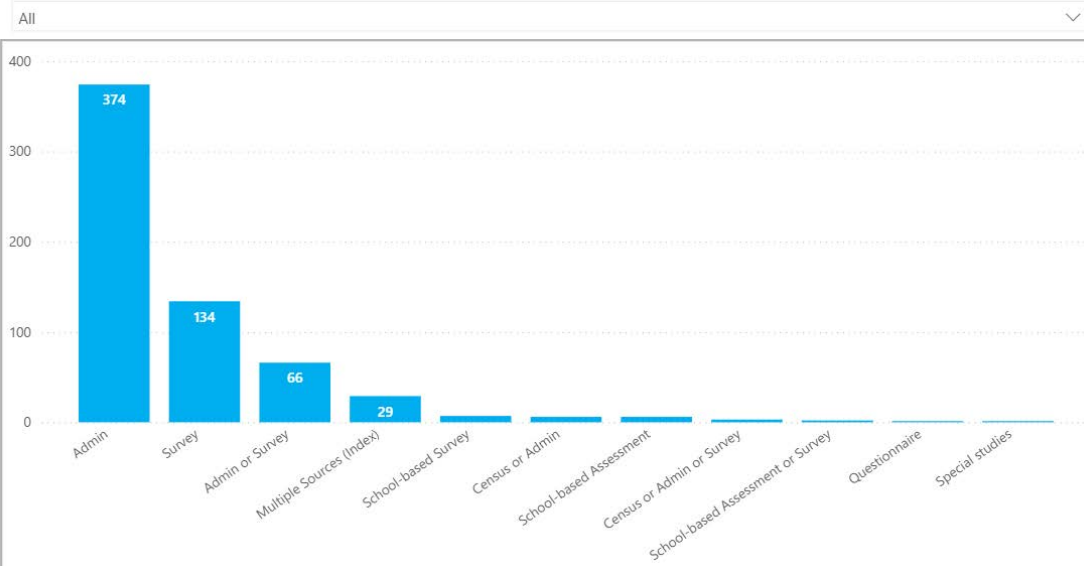
